All bookings are accepted subject to the conditions imposed by the service provider & HCUSA, including but not limited to, the airline, cruise line, rail, coach, hotel, restaurants, insurance & other companies, firms or persons concerned with the trip. HCUSA will make no refund in the event of their delay, cancellations, overbooking, strike, force majeure or for elements of the package not used by customer.
